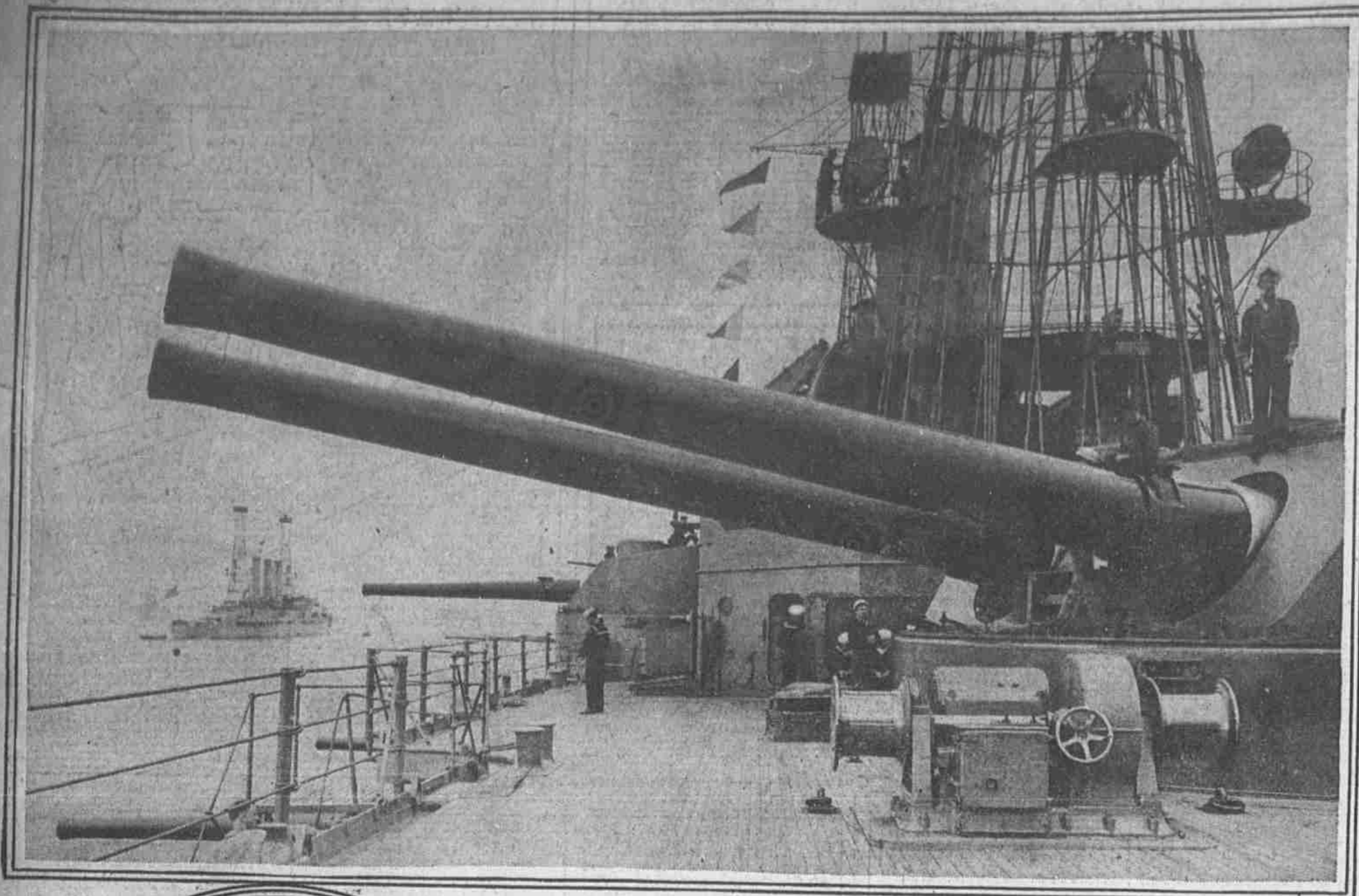

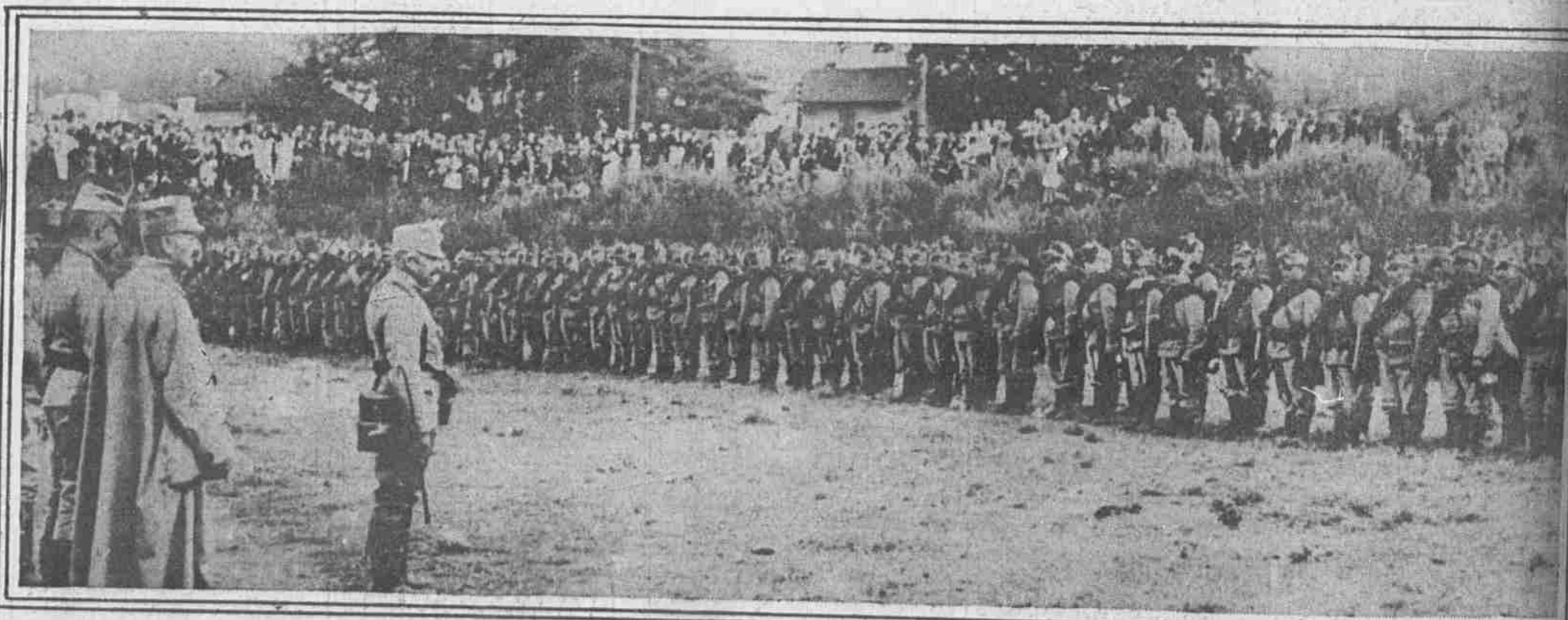
THESE GUNS SOON TO BE POINTED AT VERA CRUZ Photo by E. Muller.
These are two of the forward rifles of the battleship Louisiana, which last night sailed from Newport, R. I., for Mexico under orders.



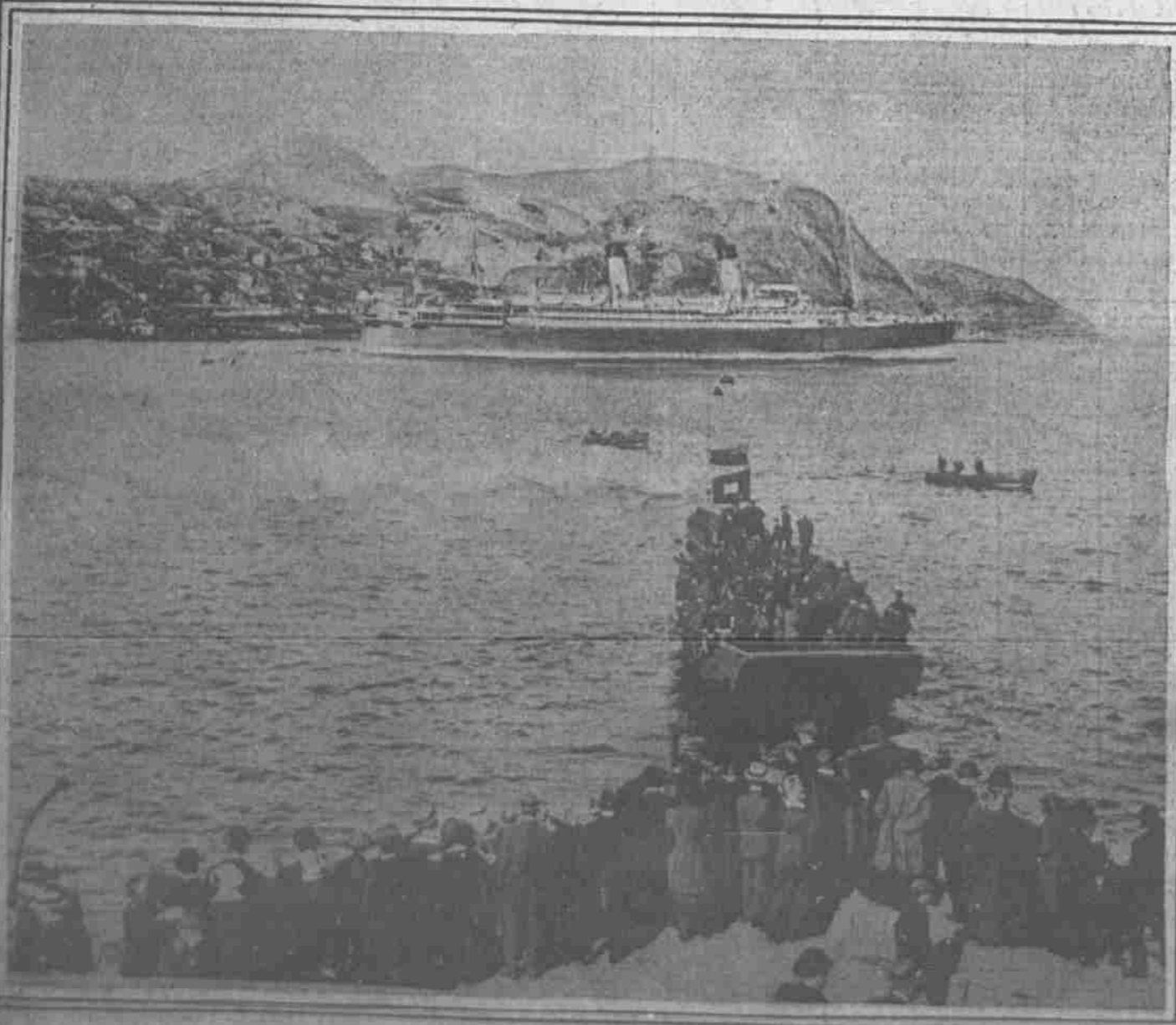
REFUGEES OF TWO FRANCO-GERMAN WARS
