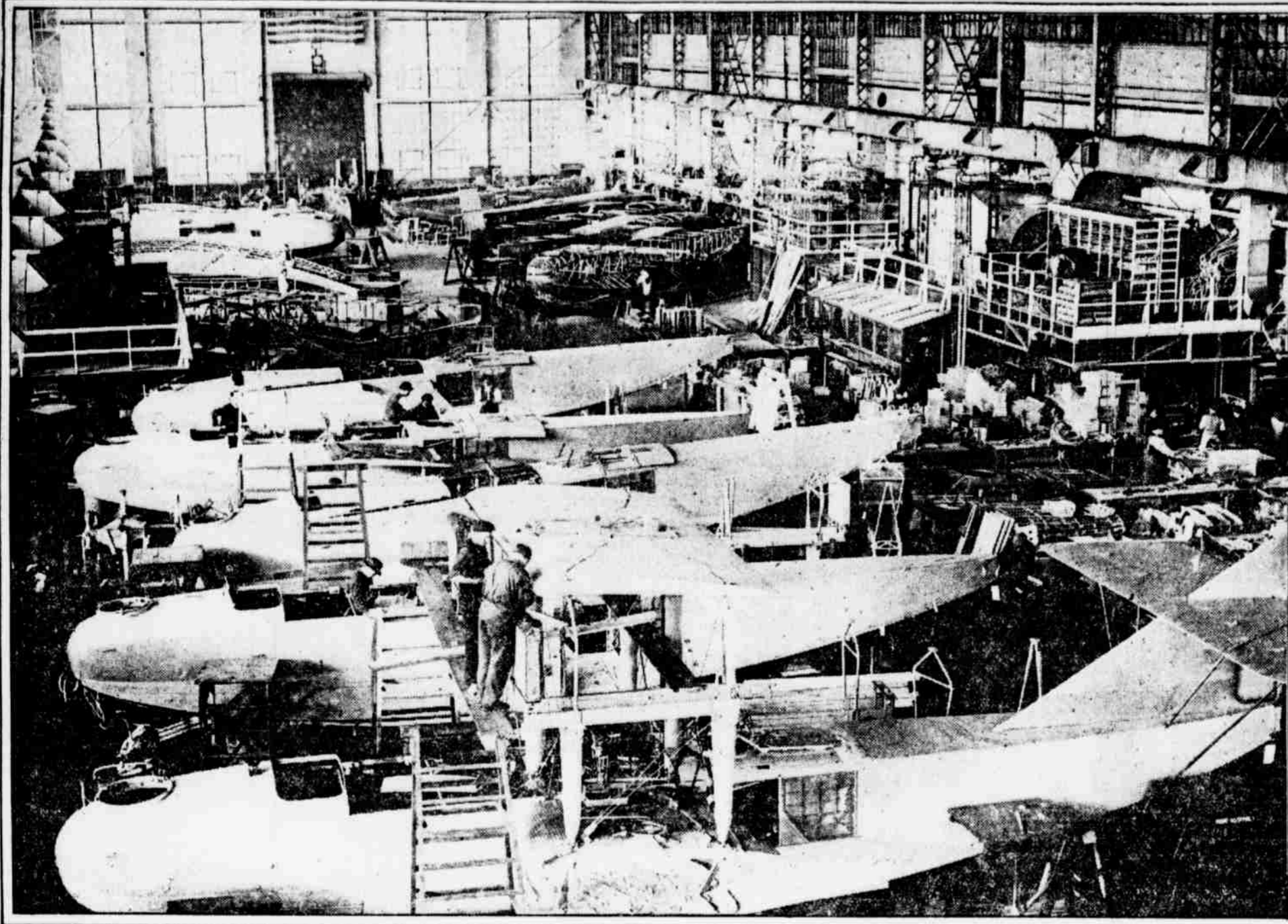


A Varied Pictorial Portrayal Gleaned by the Camera From Here, There and Everywhere



IN THE HULL ROOM OF THE NAVAL AIRCRAFT FACTORY at League Island workers are as busy as ever completing airplanes for the navy



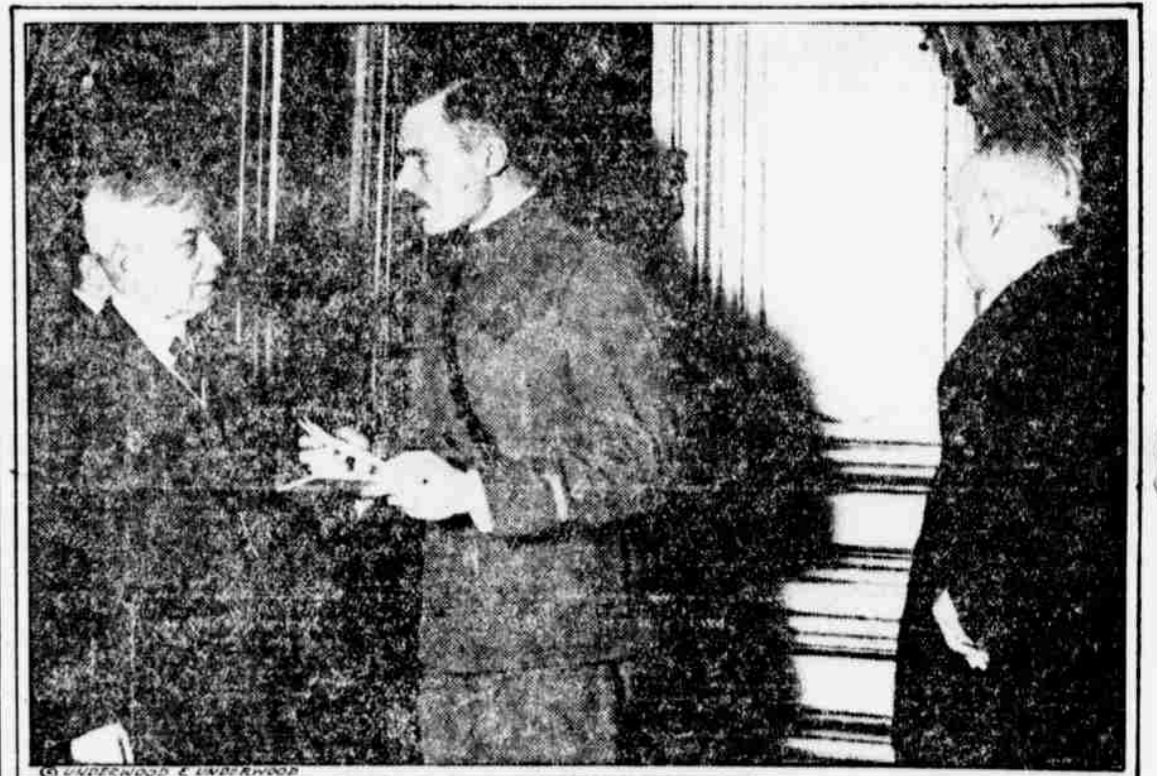

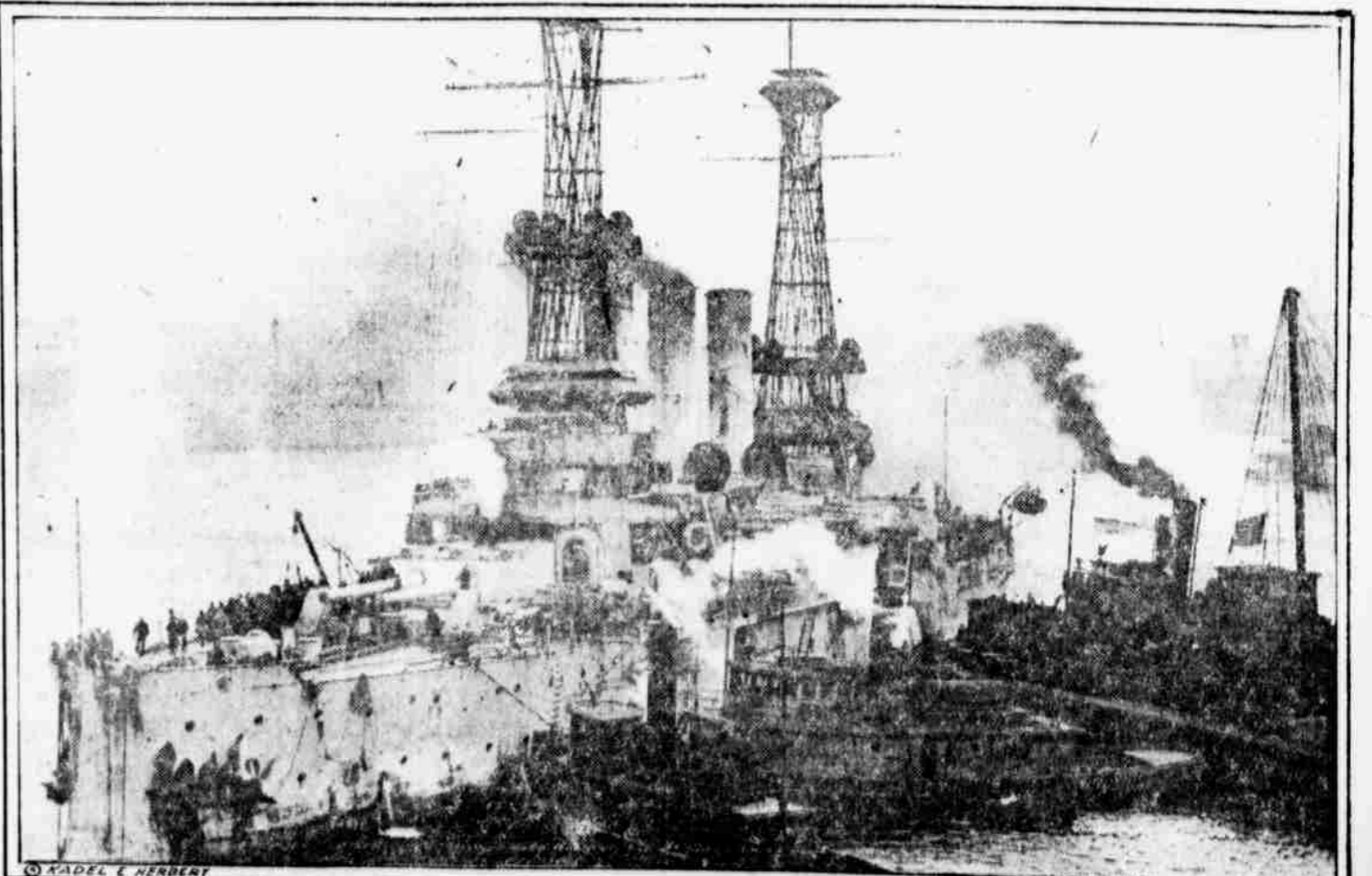
