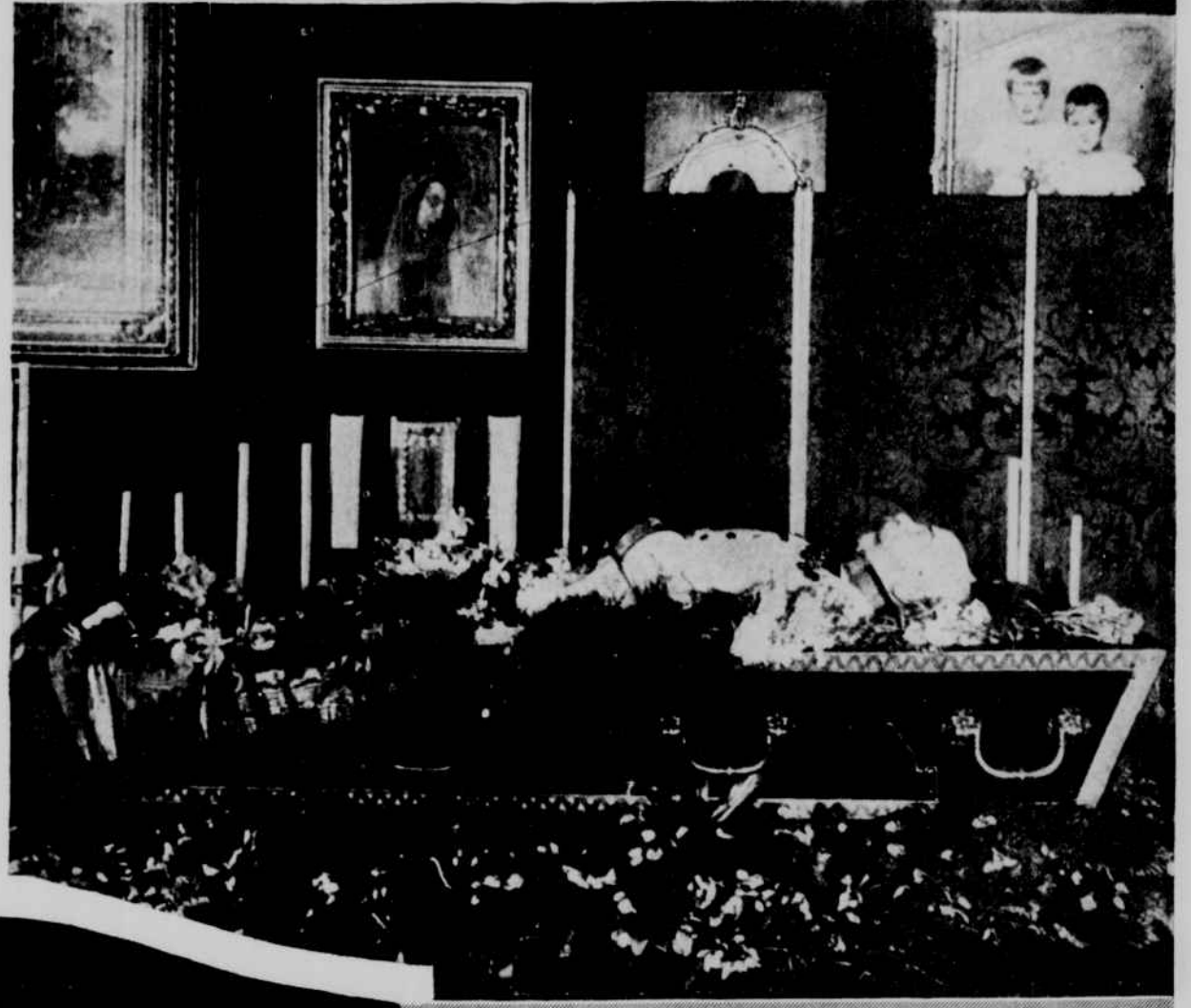




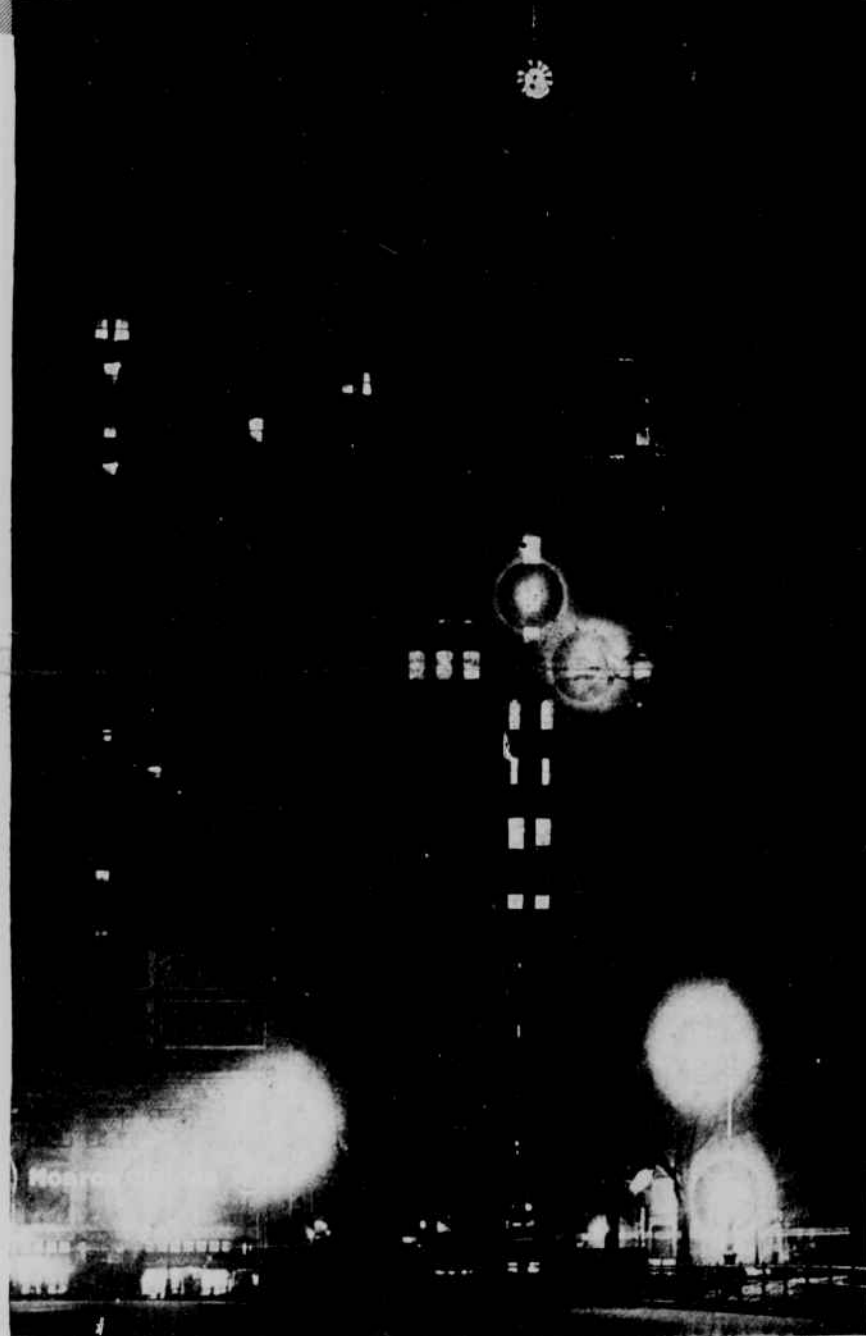
**First photographs of the funeral of the Emperor Francis Joseph**

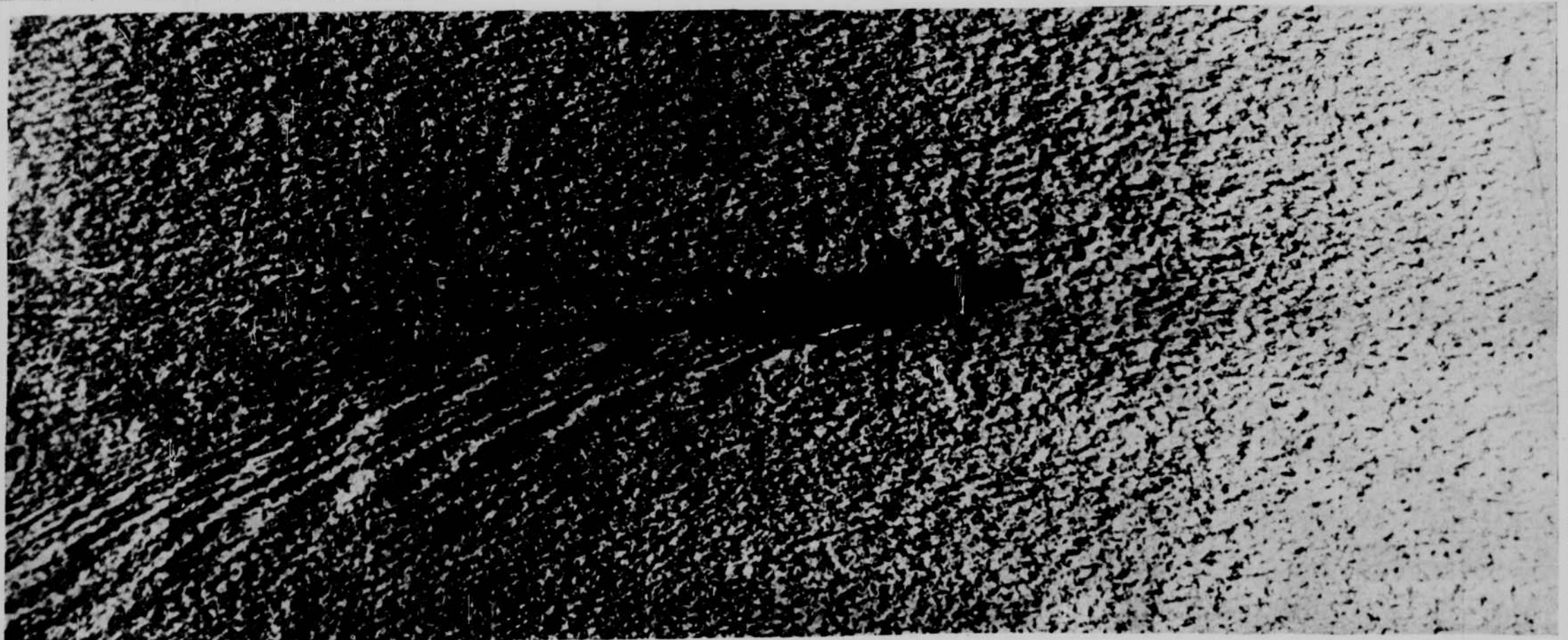
**Two hundred and thirty children** were Christmas guests of the sailors on the battleship New York. Thelma Wilkening, five years old, danced for them while the ship's band played.
