**TEMPE TO ENFORCE WATER ORDINANCE**

TEMPE, Feb. 12.—The city council decided at their regular business session, Thursday evening, to strictly enforce the ordinance concerning the collection of water rates. The town clerk has requested that a copy of section 31, ordinance 63, known as the water ordinance, be given for the benefit of property owners and also their tenants. It reads as follows:

Section 31.—In all cases where water is used on any premises, the property owner or his agent must settle for the full amount of the rents charged against the property, and the collector of water rates shall not receive pay from tenants by means of said tenants settling to pay the whole rent or rate charged against such property.

Mr. Irwin, living on Farmers avenue, came before the council asking that a new diversion rate be put in the Wilson ditch, south of the point where the railroad track crosses the ditch, the property owners benefited by this.

Mr. Deane, engineer representing the railroad company, came before the council with a proposition to deed a strip of land, 27 1/2 feet wide and 200 feet long, lying between the west side of the track in Farmers avenue, in consideration that the town would not now or in the future ask for a crossing on Fifth street. The council rejected the proposition.

H. L. Hancock, city engineer, presented a diagram of the assessments for paving the highway on Mill avenue
