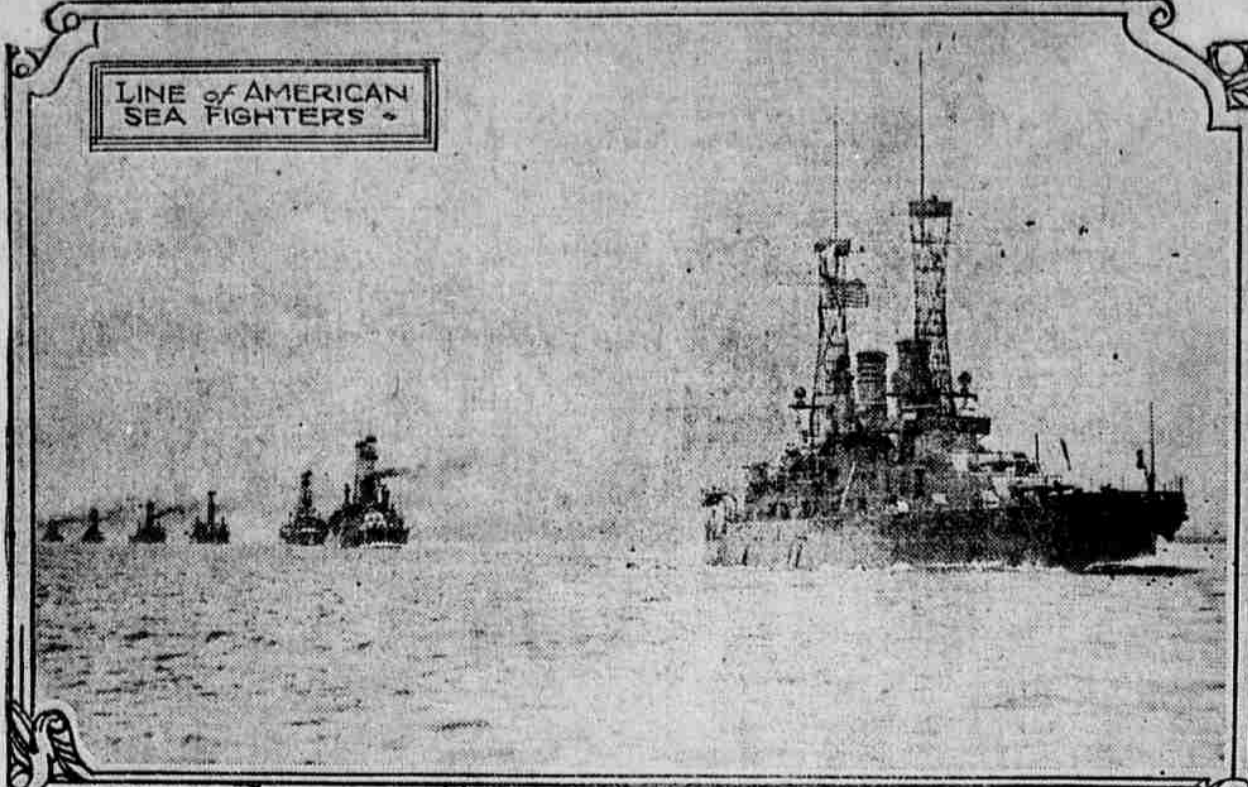


UNCLE SAM'S SEA FIGHTERS TO GET BIG WELCOME

The greeting to the fleet has been talked of in every direction for days. After the review and usual ceremonies the big fighters will cast anchor along the beautiful Hudson, where all may see how valiantly are Uncle Sam's big vessels.

Greatest Naval Parade To Be Seen This Summer

Nothing in History of Warships To Compare With Coming Sight at New York.

The most wonderful naval pageant ever known is to be seen at New York some time during the coming summer.

Battered warships, returning from Europe will join the freshest fighting craft that have not been across. It is expected that fully one hundred fighting ships will pass Manhattan Island and come to anchor in the broad expanse of the lower Hudson. Thirty thousand men, at least, will get "shore leave" for a period of fourteen days. One object of the pageant, it is said by Assistant Secretary Roosevelt and Admiral Sims, is to give "the boys" a much needed rest and a period of recreation after their long and nerve-taxing duties in European waters.

Great efforts will be made by the Y. M. C. A., the K. of C., the Jewish Welfare Board and similar organizations to see that the returning sailors have the right kind of entertainment on shore.

Many Want To Go Overseas

Recruits Join 'Peace Army' That Calls for 50,000.

The United States Army Recruiting Office, 416 Adams St., Toledo, O., is being overwhelmed with questions of applicants who are seeking to enter the "peace army" or to go overseas with the volunteer force of 50,000 men which was recently authorized.

The character and appearance of the men who are being accepted indicates that the future army of the United States will be a far superior force to that of the past.

Recruiting office attaches declare that the choice of any branch of service, the choice of almost any place in the world where the enlistment can be served and the choice of the length of service—one to three years—is responsible for the large number of applicants.

The recruiting offices announce that there are vacancies for 10 men in the Motor Transport Corps for service in Panama and that men will be accepted for all branches of the service, including the air service. Also that men will be accepted, in addition to the 50,000 authorized for the A. E. F., for service in the Philippines, China, Hawaii and Panama.

The little town was highly excited over the announced engagement of the 19-year-old widow to Mr. Hoary.

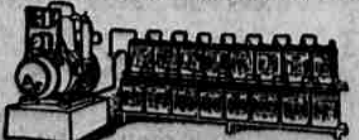

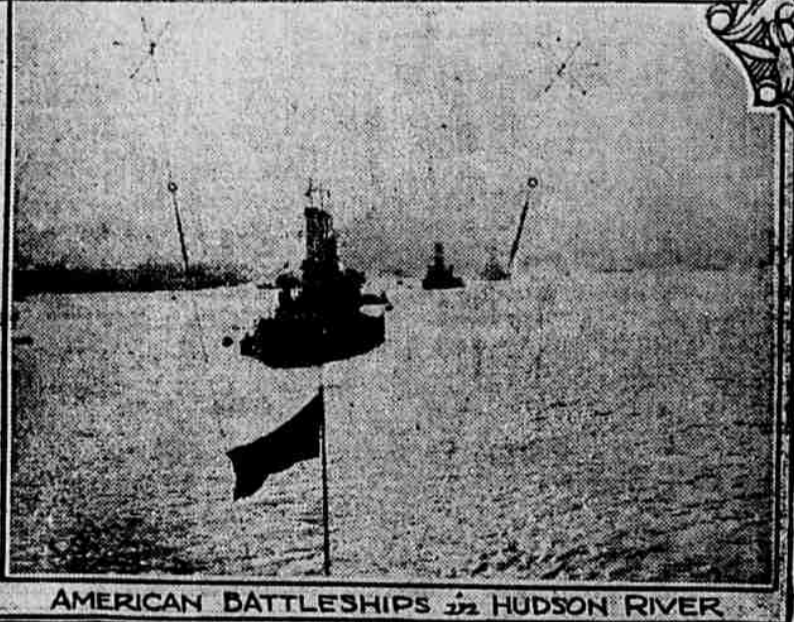

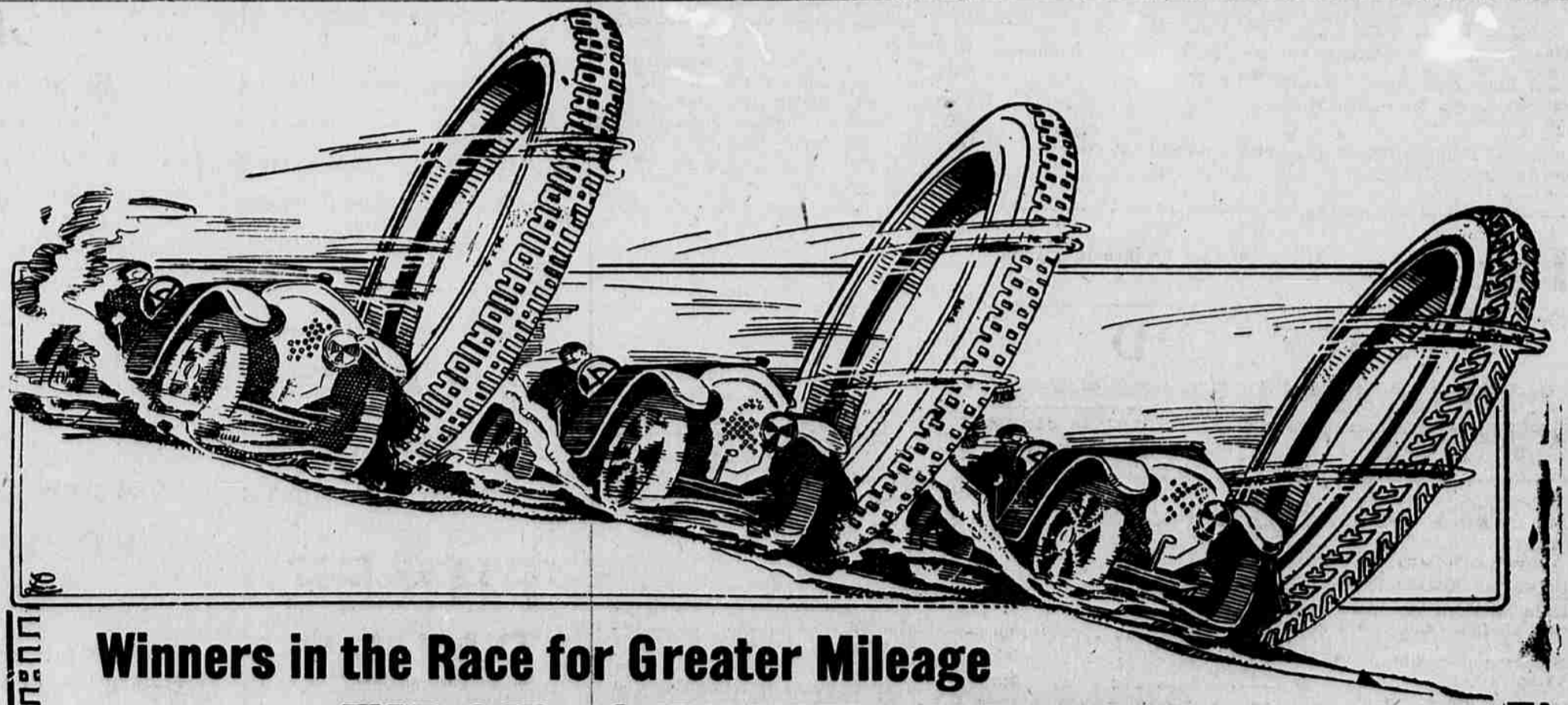
