Forty Aerial Engagements, During Which Guynemer Wings 23d Machine.

BRITISH RAID TEUTONS.

Lively Bombardment in the Region of Sailly-Saillisel and Ablaincourt.

With About 4,000 Fresh Troops He Makes Unsuccessful Attack on Chihuahua.

JUAREZ, Mexico, Nov. 24.—Francisco Villa, with a force estimated at 4,000 men, renewed his attacks on Chihuahua City to-day and was again repulsed and driven from his positions outside the city it was announced at military headquarters here shortly after noon to-day.

The fighting was for the possession of the first and second line of Government trenches, it was announced officially and resulted in victory for the de facto forces.

CHIHUAHUA CITY, Mexico, Nov. 24.—One general, two colonels and 100 men of the Carranza forces were killed during the fighting yesterday between Carranza troops and Villa bandits.

Four hundred men of the Villa command are known to have been killed and left on the battlefield. The names of the Carranza officers killed have been suppressed by the military censor.
