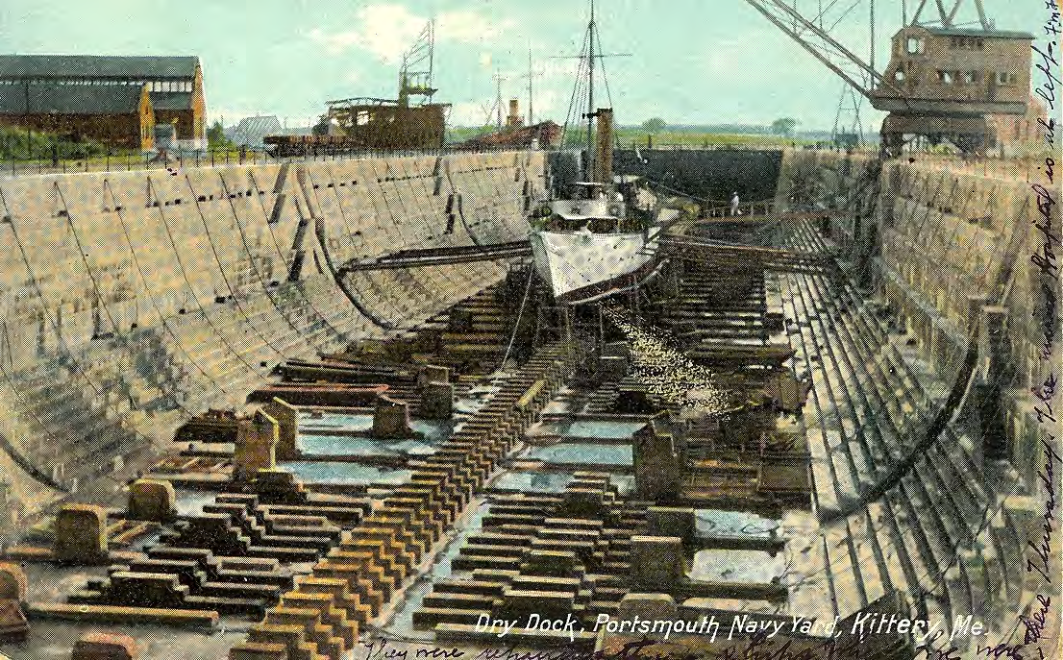

is the part down Washington

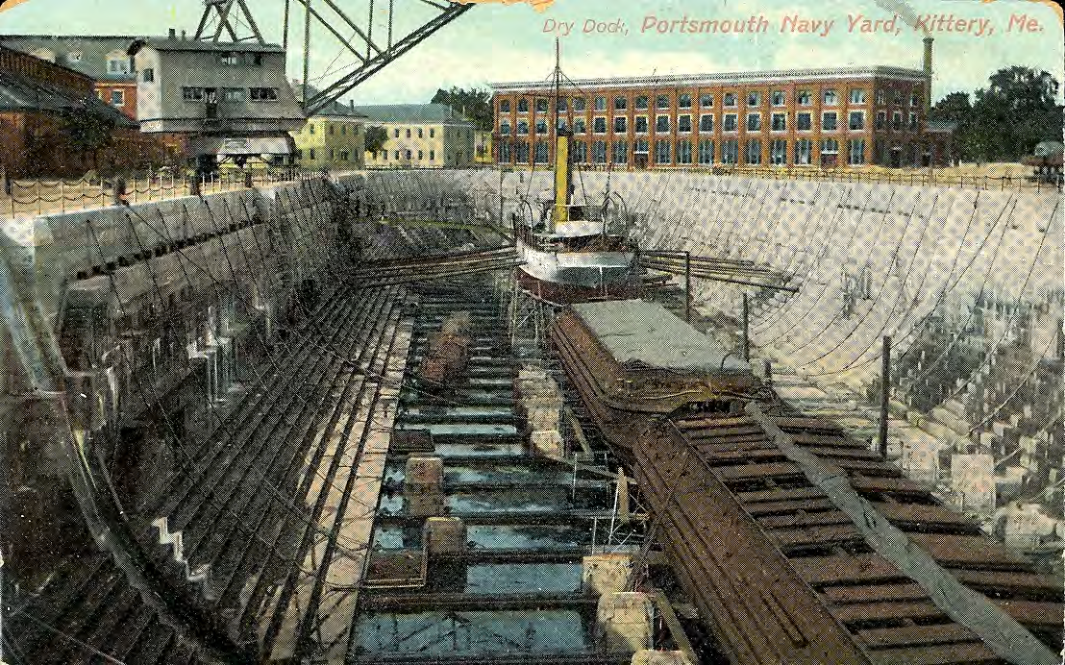


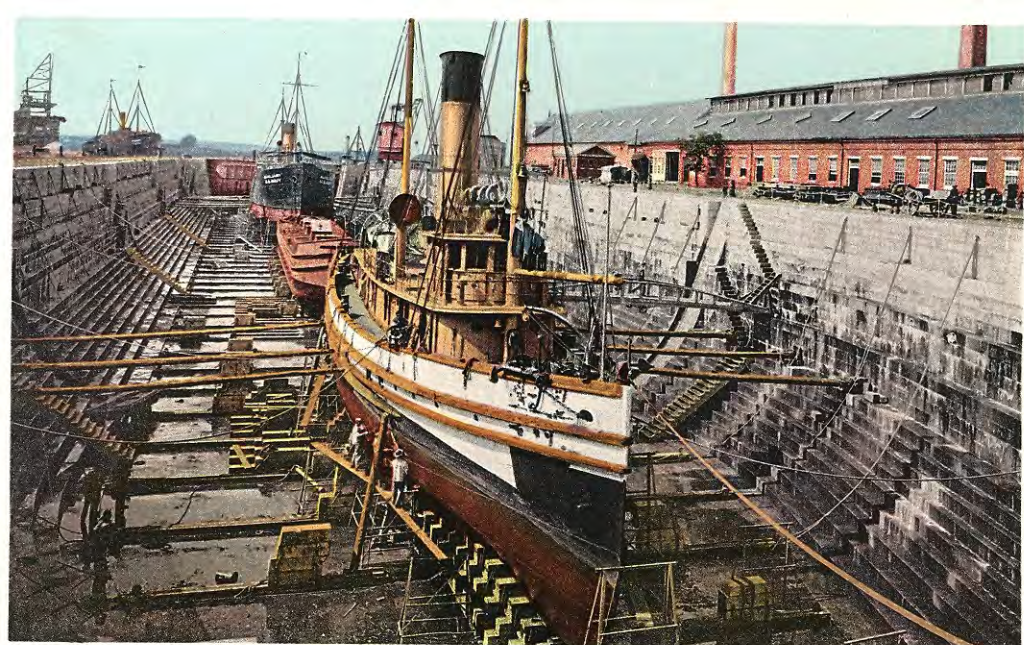

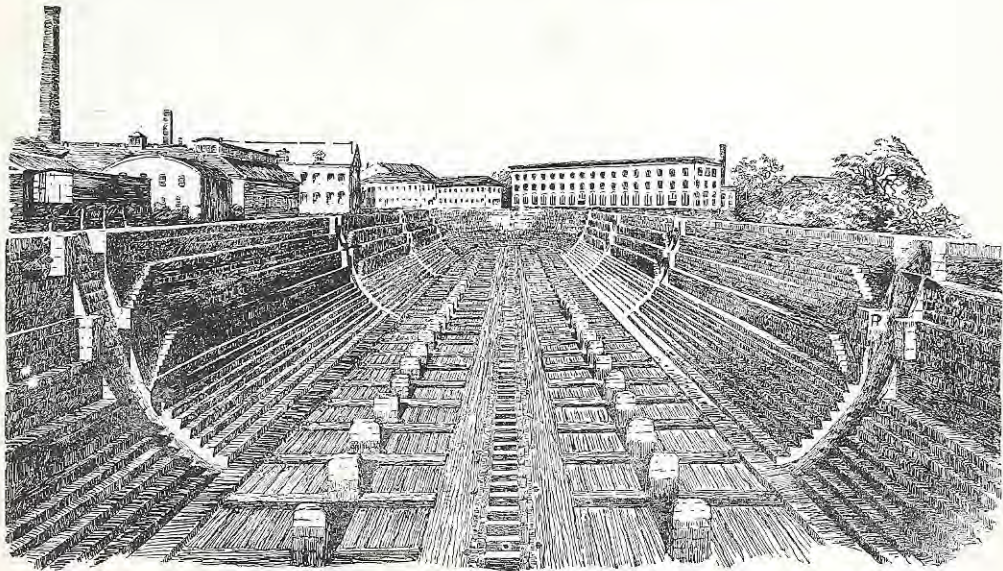

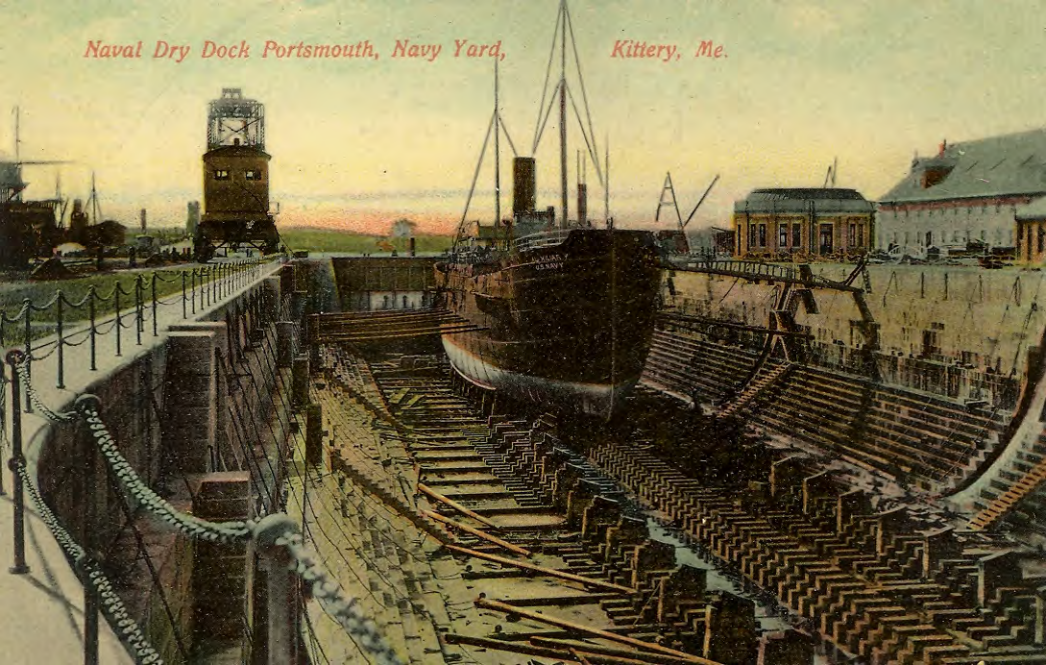

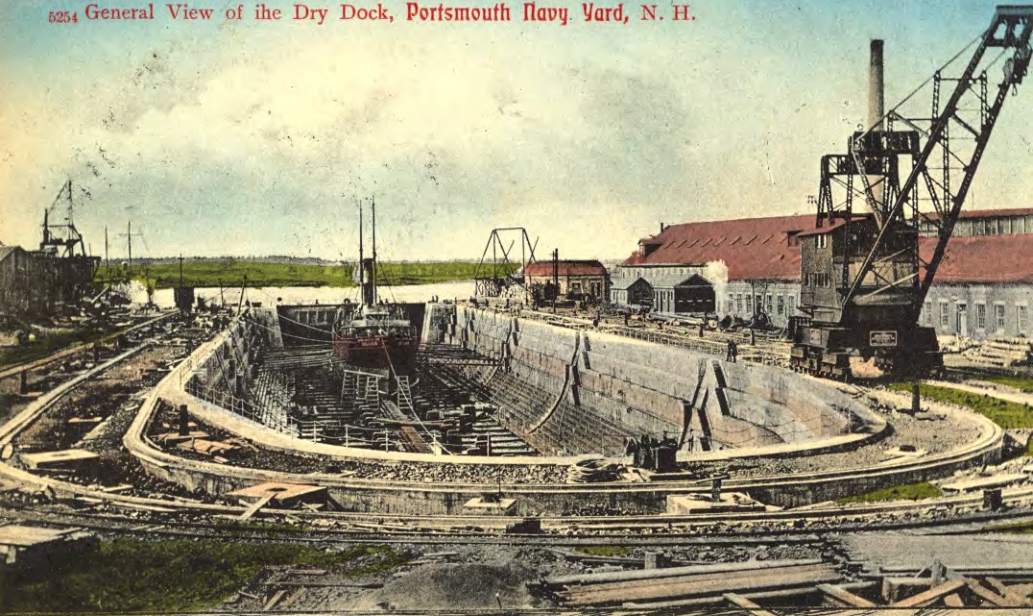

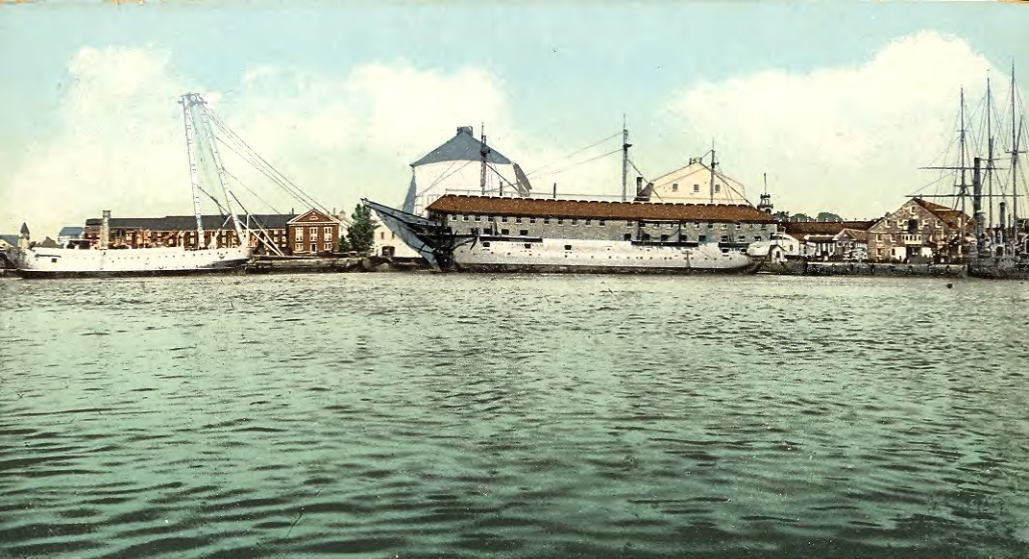
