Miss Grace Darling, the photoplay star, has introduced this fad at Palm Beach, with the result that several factories are booked ahead on orders for boy doll babies.

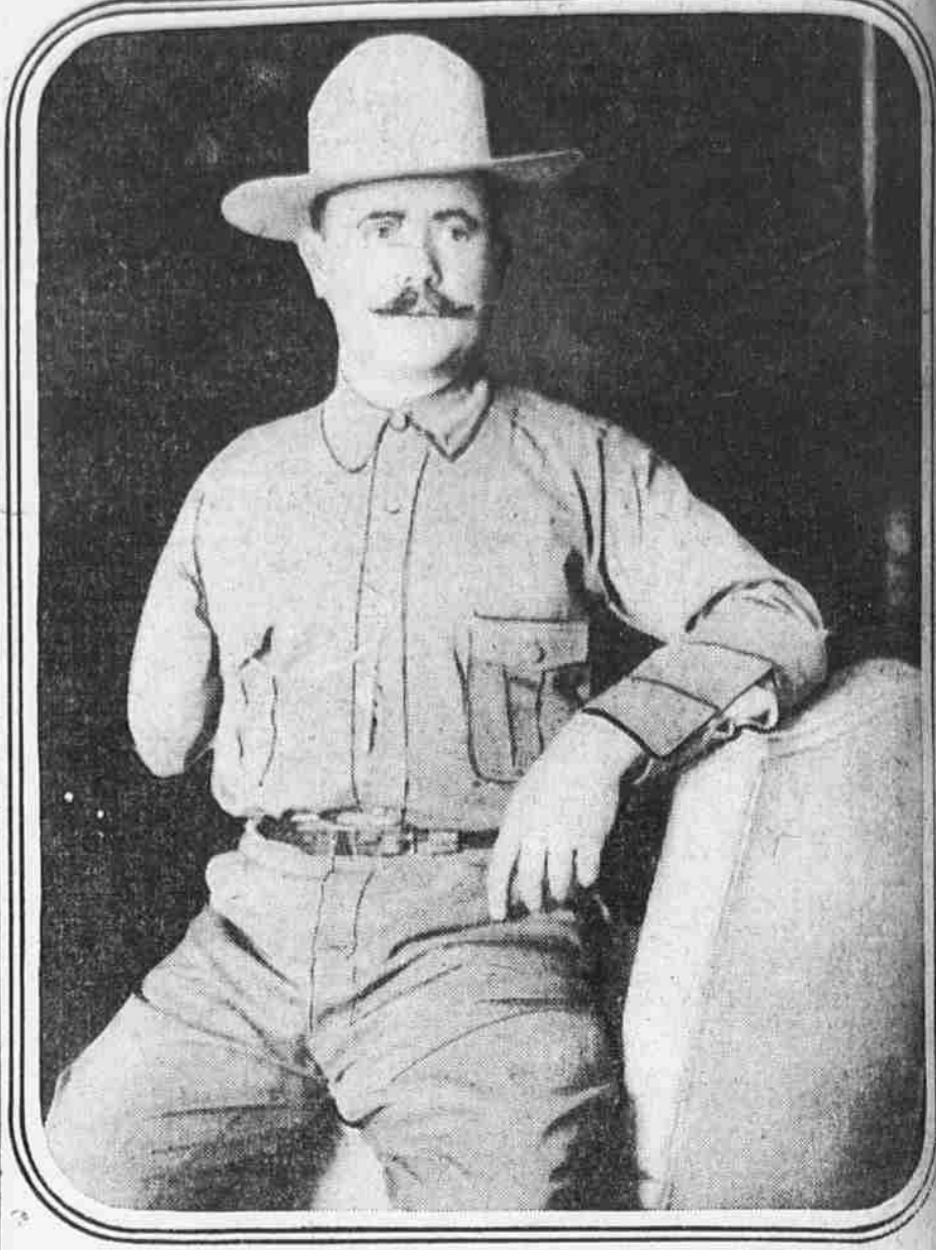

General Obregon, whose forces broke Villa's power, for a long time was reported dead, but this picture shows he recovered from his injury.

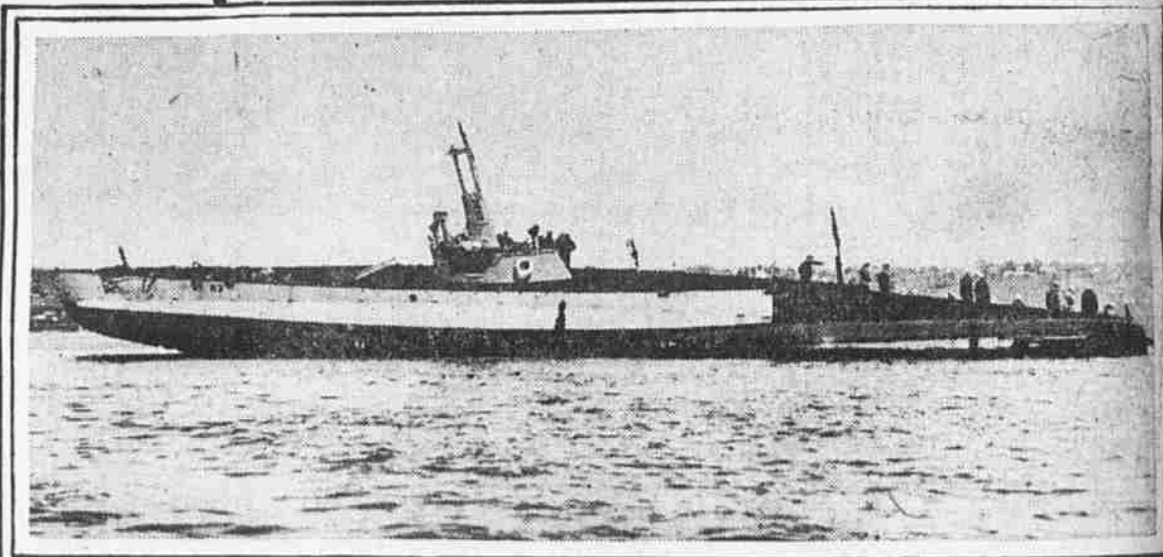

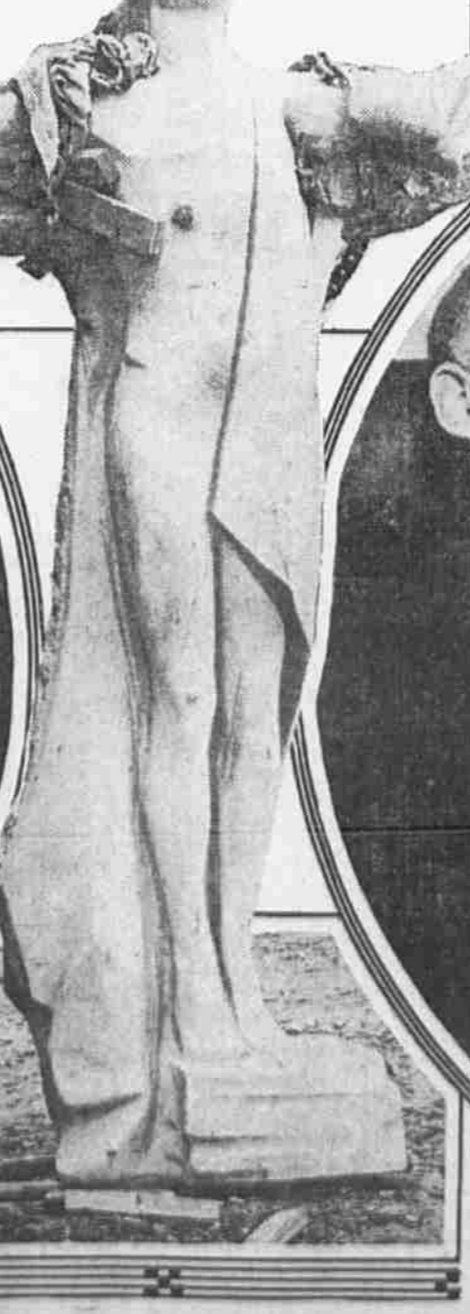
