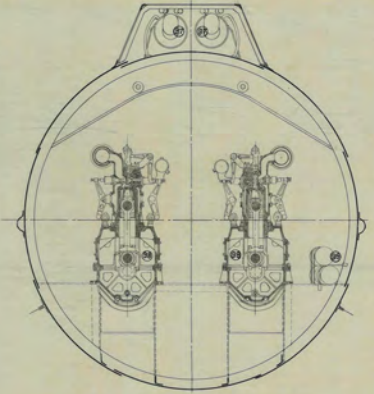
HULL PROFILE

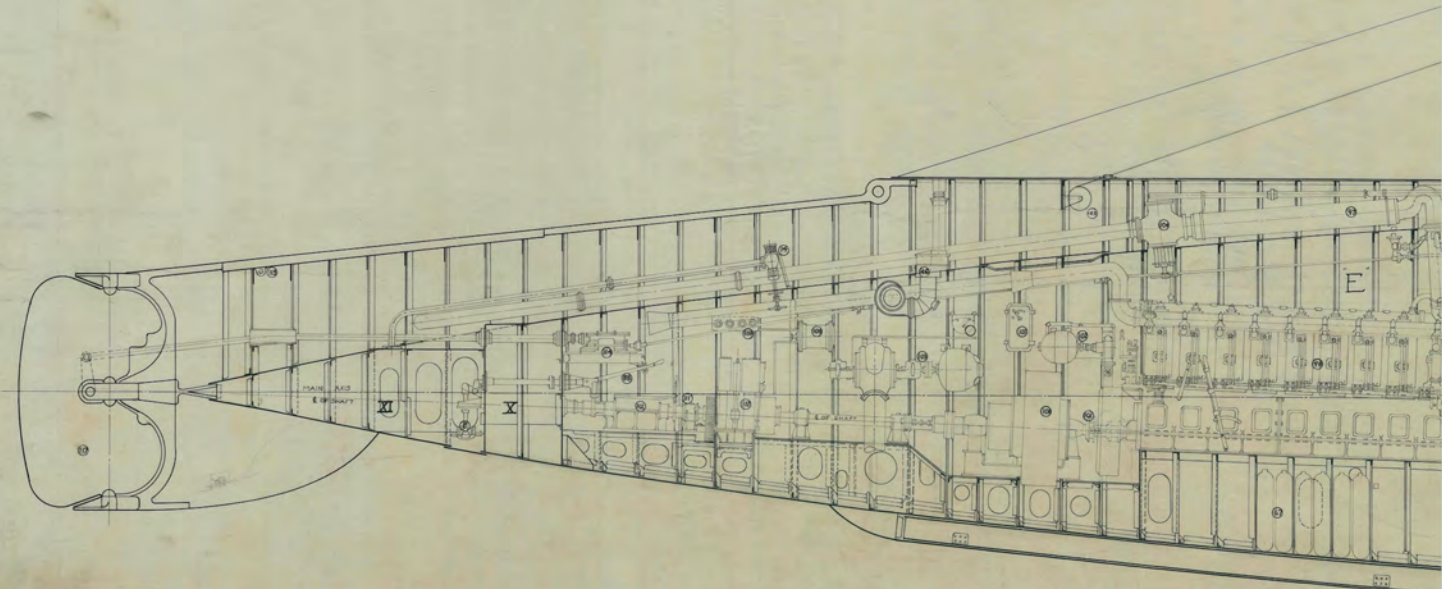
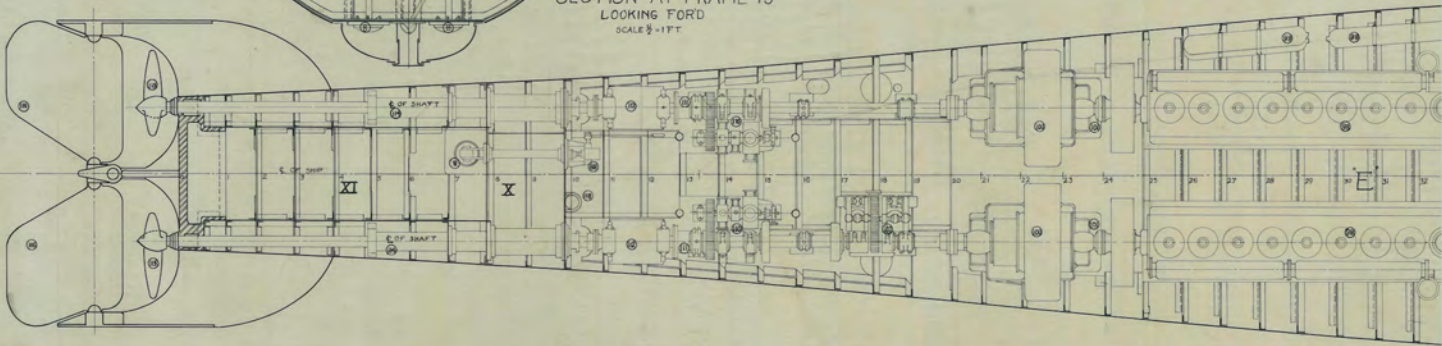
