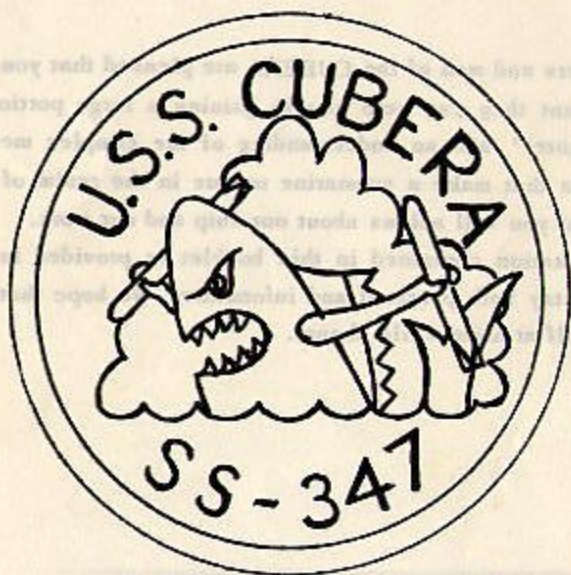
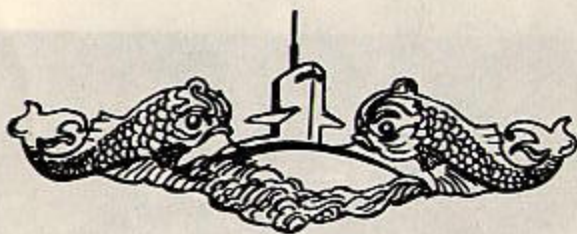

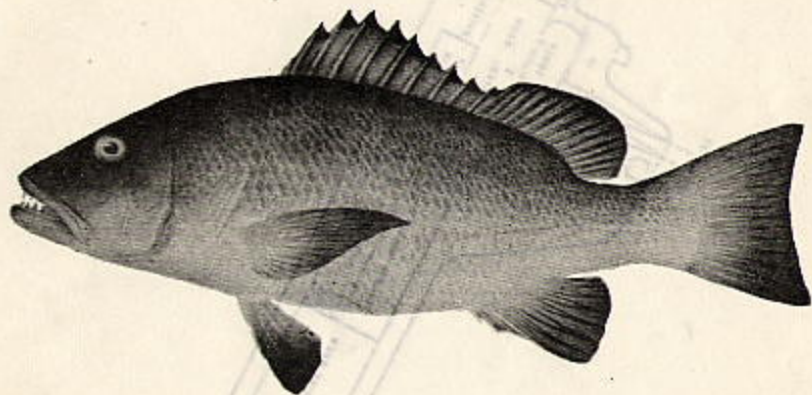

Propulsion	Diesel-electric plant with storage batteries and direct-drive electric motors



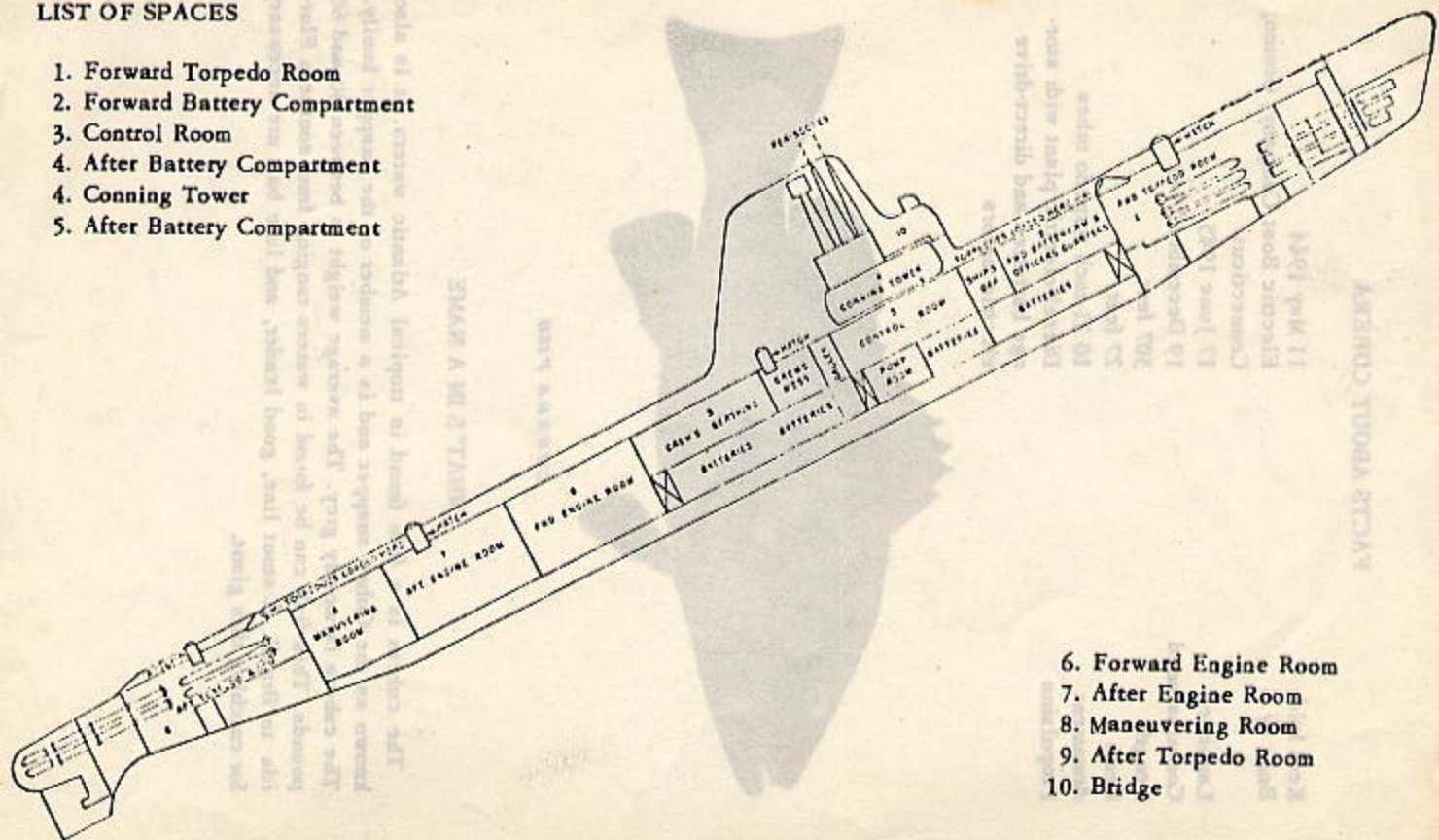
CUBERA FISH

WHAT'S IN A NAME

The cubera is a fish found in tropical Atlantic waters. It is also known as the Cuban snapper and is a member of the snapper family. The cubera is mostly grey. The average weight is between 30 and 60 pounds. This fish can be found in waters ranging from southern Florida to Brazil. A stout line, good leader, and lure bait are necessary for catching this giant.
