At sea, he served with Fighter Squadron (VF) 31 "Tomcatters" deploying twice aboard USS <u>Abraham</u> <u>Lincoln</u> (CVN 72); as strike operations officer in Carrier Air Wing (CVW) 7 deploying aboard USS <u>Dwight D. Eisenhower</u> (CVN 69); as a department head in Strike Fighter Squadron (VFA) 32 "Swordsmen," deploying aboard USS <u>Harry S. Truman</u> (CVN 75); as commanding officer of VFA-211 "Checkmates," leading them on an around-the world deployment aboard USS <u>Theodore Roosevelt</u> (CVN 71); as operations officer for Carrier Strike Group (CSG) 4; as executive officer of Abraham Lincoln and as commanding officer of USS <u>Blue Ridge</u> (LCC 19) from June 2022 to November 2023; in October 2024 he assumed command of USS <u>Ronald Reagan</u> (CVN 76).

His shore tours include as an instructor in VFA-122 "Flying Eagles" and VFA-106 "Gladiators," and the Joint and Combined Warfighting School with subsequent service on the Joint Staff in the J-3 Operations Directorate at the Pentagon. He has accumulated over 2,800 flight hours and over 650 arrested

landings over the course of combat deployments supporting Operations *Southern Watch*, *Enduring Freedom*, *Iraqi Freedom*, *New Dawn* and *Inherent Resolve*.

His personal decorations include the Legion of Merit (two awards), Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (three awards), Individual Air Medal with Combat "V", Strike Flight Air Medal (seven awards), the Navy Commendation Medal (five awards including one with Combat "V"), the Navy Achievement Medal and various campaign, unit and individual awards.
