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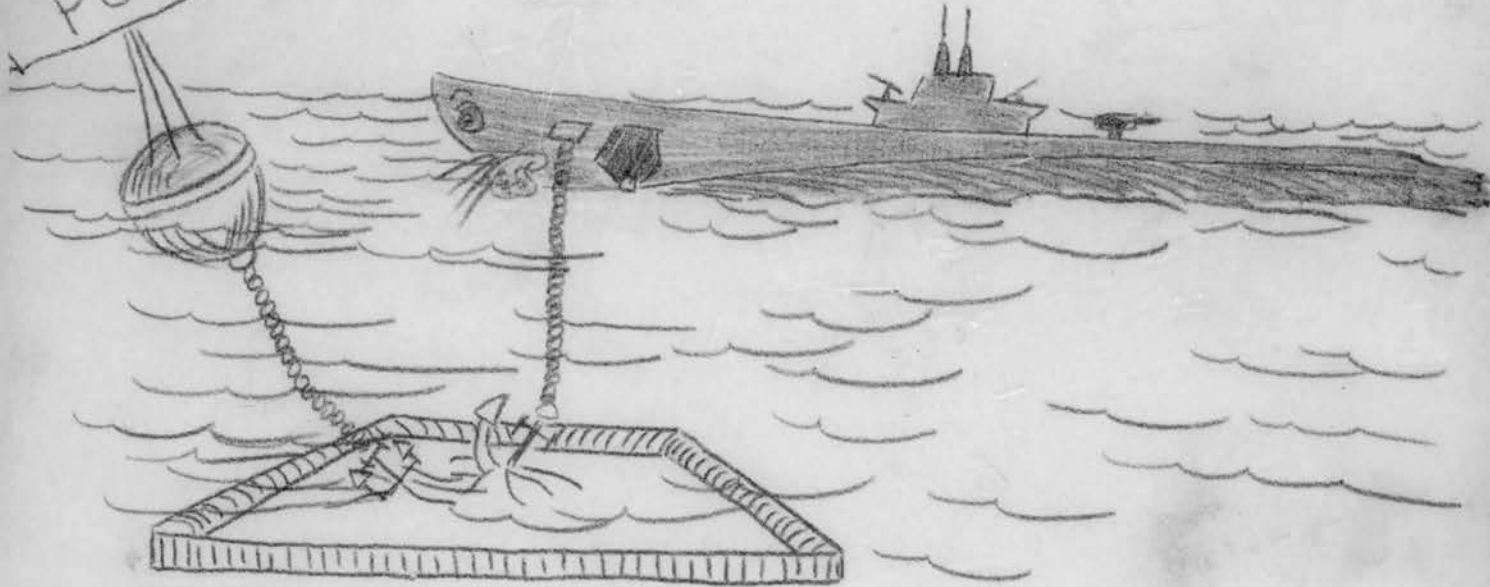

ROME:- DIPLOMATIC REPORTS MONDAY SAID KEN HARADA, JAPANESE AMBASSADOR TO THE HOLY SEE HAD EXPRESSED JAPAN'S "READINESS FOR PEACE" ON CERTAIN CONDITIONS AT AN AUDIENCE WITH POPE PIUS SATURDAY. CONFIRMATION OF THE REPORT WAS LACKING AS ALL SUCH CONVERSATIONS WITH THE PONTIFF ARE CONFIDENTIAL BUT USUALLY WELL INFORMED PERSONS WITH CLOSE VATICAN CONNECTIONS INSISTED THAT HARADA HAD SO EXPRESSED HIMSELF.

NEW YORK:- JAPANESE NAVAL HIGH COMMAND WAS RESHIFTED MONDAY "IN VIEW OF THE PRESENT GRAVE AIR SITUATION". NAVY MINISTER SHIGETARO SHIMADA WAS REPLACED BY THE RELATIVELY OBSCURE ADMIRAL NAOKUNI NOMURA FROM THE NAVY'S HIERARCHY BUT A DOMEI NEWS AGENCY BROADCAST SAID ADMIRAL SHIMADA WOULD RETAIN HIS POSITION OF NAVY CHIEF OF STAFF. TOKYO RADIO WHICH BROKE THE NEWS FIRST IN AN ENGLISH LANGUAGE BROADCAST TO NORTH AMERICA SAID SIMPLY THAT SHIMADA HAD RESIGNED BUT DOMEI ASSERTED THAT HE HAD BEEN "RELIEVED OF HIS POST".

SOUTHEAST ASIA COMMAND HQS KANDY CEYLON:- A FORMIDABLE ENEMY BARRIER TO THE ALLIED ADVANCE SOUTHWARD IN INDIA ALONG THE TIDDIM ROAD HAS BEEN REMOVED WITH OCCUPATION OF A HEAVILY FORTIFIED VILLAGE AFTER IT HAD BEEN REDUCED BY A TREMENDOUS ARTILLERY BARRAGE HQS ANNOUNCED MONDAY.

CHUNGKING:- FIGHTING BITTERLY WITH HOPE FOR RELIEF INCIRCLED CHINESE TROOPS IN THE CANTON HANKOW RAIL JUNCTION OF HENGYANG HAVE THROWN BACK FRESH AND HEAVY JAPANESE ATTACKS ON THE CITY BUT A SECOND BREAKTHROUGH HAS BEEN MADE BY THE ENEMY IN ATTACKS FROM THE SOUTHWEST SUBURBS THE CHINESE HIGH COMMAND ADMITTED MONDAY NIGHT.

ROME:- ALLIED FORCES BORED STEADILY INTO GERMAN DEFENSES ACROSS ITALY MONDAY BRITISH EIGHTH ARMY TROOPS BURSTING ACROSS THE ARNO RIVER NORTHWEST OF THE CAPTURED PROVINCIAL CAPITAL OF AREZZO AT THE CENTER OF THE FRONT AND AMERICAN TROOPS DRIVING WITHIN FOUR MILES OF THE HEART OF LIVORNO ON THE WEST COAST. THE SWIFT ADVANCE OF EIGHTH ARMY TANKS AND INFANTRY BEYOND AREZZO WHICH THEY STORMED EARLY SUNDAY SO SURPRISED THE ENEMY THAT THEY WERE UNABLE TO DESTROY A BRIDGE ACROSS THE ARNO.

CANBERRA:- PREDICTING JAPAN WOULD BE AS DECISIVELY BEATEN AS THE NAZIS WHEN NIPPON IS HIT WITH FULL BRITISH AND AMERICAN LAND AND AIR FORCES AUSTRALIAN PRIME MINISTER JOHN CURTIN TOLD PARLIAMENT MONDAY THAT BRITAIN'S EFFORTS AGAINST THE RISING SUN'S EMPIRE MUST AWAIT GERMANY'S DEFE

SUPREME HQS ALLIED EXP FORCE:- ST LO AND EVRECY WERE CRACKED MONDAY BY THE AMERICAN AND BRITISH IN THEIR GREATEST COORDINATED DRIVE SINCE D DAY AND FIGHTING RAGED MONDAY NIGHT IN THE STREETS ON BOTH THOSE STRONGHOLDS OF THE ENEMY'S NORMANDY LINE. MOVING LIKE WRAITHS IN THE MORNING MIST THE AMERICANS UNDER ORDERS TO ADVANCE STEADILY BAYONETTED THE ENEMY IN HIS FOXHOLES AND SWEEPED INTO THE ST LO FROM THE EAST AFTER SEVEN DAYS OF ASSAULT. THE GERMANS HIDDEN IN THE RUBBLE AND TUNNELED UNDER THE RUINS LIKE STALIN-GRAD IN MINIATURE FOUGHT BACK FIERCELY LEFT THIRTY OF THEIR TANKS WRECKED IN THE WAKE OF TWO COUNTERATTACKS AND IT APPEARED THAT THE FINAL REDUCTION OF ST LO STILL WAS SEVERAL DAYS AWAY. AMERICAN ARTILLERY HOWEVER MOVED UP IN FORCE AND THREATENED TO DRIVE THE ENEMY'S GUNS BACK FROM THE HILLS SOUTH OF ST LO WHICH HAVE MADE THE ROAD JUNCTION A KEYPOINT IN THE ENEMY'S LOWER CHERBOURG PENINSULA DEFENSES.

MOSCOW:- A GERMAN ARMY OF SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND MEN MARCHED THROUGH RUSSIA'S CAPITAL MONDAY NOT IN THE GOOSE STEPPING TRIUMPH OF THEIR LEADERS DREAMS BUT WITH THE SLOGGING TRAMP OF BEATEN, CAPTURED SOLDIERS. A MILLION MUSCOVITES STODELY WATCHED THIS GREATEST PROCESS IN MOSCOW SINCE THE RED ARMY DARINGLY WENT AHEAD WITH ITS PARADE THROUGH RED SQUARE NOVEMBER SEVENTH, 1941 WHILE THIS SAME ENEMY THUNDERED AT THE CITY'S GATES.

NEW YORK:- THE BRITISH RADIO SAID MONDAY THAT THE NAZI LEADER ALFRED ROSENBERG "HAS BEEN PUT IN CHARGE OF THE IMMEDIATE EVACUATION OF A PART OF EAST PRUSSIA". FOR THE TIME BEING THE EVACUATION WILL BE LIMITED TO THE REGION EAST OF THE RAILROAD FROM TILSITTO IN STENBURG.

NEW YORK:- A NINE HUNDRED POUND POLAR BEAR CHEWED THE RIGHT ARM OF MISS CATHERINE SEARLESS, A TWENTY-FOUR YEAR OLD DAUGHTER OF WEALTHY RUG MANUFACTURER EARLY MONDAY WHEN SHE AND THREE COMPANIONS CAPPED A NIGHT CLUB PARTY BY VISITING CENTRAL PARK ZOO. POLICE SAID WHEN THE GIRL CLIMBED OVER A THREE FOOT GUARD RAIL AND WAVED A HANDKERCHIEF THROUGH THE STEEL BARS OF THE BEAR ENCLOSURE THE BEAR GRASPED HER ARM AND GNAWED IT FROM FINGER TIPS TO ELBOW. THE ARM LATER WAS AMPUTATED NEAR THE SHOULDER. HER CONDITION WAS SERIOUS BUT SURGEONS HAVE GIVEN HER A CHANCE TO LIVE. MISS SEARLESS WHO HAD BEEN ACTIVE AS A VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE DRIVER RESIDES IN A PARK AVENUE APARTMENT. HER PARENTS MR AND MRS HENRY MALCOLM SEARLESS OF RAHWAY NJ WERE CALLED FROM THEIR SUMMER PLACE AT LAKE PLACID.

RADIO PRESS

WASHINGTON:- APPOINTMENT OF BRIG GEN RAY I OWENS JUST RETURNED FROM THE SOUTH PACIFIC AS DEPUTY CHIEF OF AIR STAFF WAS ANNOUNCED MONDAY BY THE WAR DEPARTMENT. OWENS, FIFTY THREE, A NATIVE OF CHILLICOTHE, MISSOURI ENTERED THE ARMY AS A PRIVATE IN JUNE, 1917. FROM LAST JAN. FIFTY UNTIL JUNE FIFTEENTH HE WAS COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE FIRST ISLAND COMMAND IN THE SOUTH PACIFIC.

CHICAGO:- DEMOCRATS BURSTED INTO THIS CONVENTION CITY BY THE TRAINLOAD MONDAY AND JUMPED INTO A SEETHING SCRAP OVER THE VICE PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATION IN WHICH SUPPORTERS OF HENRY WALLACE TALKED ABOUT TELEPHONING AN SOS TO PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT. THE BITTER LINES OVER SECOND PLACE ON THE 1944 PARTY TICKET WERE EXPECTED TO BECOME MORE SHARPLY DEFINED AFTER RELEASE OF A LETTER IN WHICH MR ROOSEVELT PURPORTEDLY MAKES A STRONG PERSONAL APPEAL FOR WALLACE AS A RUNNING MATE. THE WALLACE CAMP WAS INTERESTED IN OBTAINING AN EVER STURDIER PRESIDENTIAL ENDORSEMENT. IT WAS ATTEMPTING TO COUNTER FILE AN EVIDENT FEELING OF SENTIMENT FOR WAR MOBILIZATION DIRECTOR JAMES F BYRNES, SECOND AN OUTRIGHT BID FOR SECOND PLACE ON THE TICKET FOR SENATE MAJORITY LEADER ALBEN W BARKLEY OF KENTUCKY WHO HAS BEEN SELECTED TO PLACE PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT'S NAME IN NOMINATION THURSDAY. BARKLEY BACKERS LET IT BE KNOWN HIS NAME WOULD BE OFFERED FOR VICE PRESIDENT.

LONDON:- A NEWLY LAUNCHED AIR OFFENSIVE AGAINST THE GERMANS SECOND LINE OF COMMUNICATIONS REACHED ITS PEAK MONDAY WHEN SOME TWO THOUSAND AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS AND FIGHTERS STRUCK FROM BRITAIN AND ITALY AT BRIDGE AND OTHER RAIL TARGETS IN A GREAT ARC AROUND PARIS AND SOUTHERN FRANCE. THESE BLOWS CAME AS THE RUSSIANS IN THE EAST DISCLOSED THAT THEIR FIGHTERS HAD BEEN ATTACKING TARGETS IN EAST PRUSSIA THUS MAKING A THREE WAY OFFENSIVE AGAINST THE GERMANS.

NEW YORK:- STEELS AND MOTORS MONDAY LED THE STOCK MARKET ON ONE OF THE MOST SUBSTANTIAL RETURNS OF THE PAST THREE MONTHS OR SO. TRANSFERS TOTTLED NEARLY A MILLION AND ONE HALF SHARES COMPARED WITH OVER A MILLION FRIDAY. CONSPICUOUS CASUALTIES WERE US STEEL, CHRYSLER, GENERAL MOTORS, US RUBBER, AMERICAN CAN, AND WESTERN UNION A. AT CHICAGO WHEAT WAS OFF 3/8 TO ONE CENT A BUSHEL.

LONDON:- THE RED ARMY FLUSHED WITH CONTINUING VICTORIES MADE "ON TO KONIGSBERG" ITS BATTLECRY MONDAY NIGHT AS IT ADVANCED WESTWARD WITHIN

(GON'T FROM PRECEDING PAGE) - FORTY MILES OF EAST PRUSSIAS ORIGINAL BOUNDARIES AND DROVE POWERFULLY INTO THE OUTER APPROACHES OF THE BIG GERMAN FORTRESS OF BIALYSTOCK AND BREST LITOVSK IN THE HEART OF OLD POLAND. THE SOVIER MIDNIGHT COMMUNIQUE ANNOUNCED STEADY EXPANSION OF THE BRIGEHEADS WEST OF THE NIEMER RIVER BELOW KAUNAS LITHUANIA, CAPTURE OF OUTPOST TOWNS WITHIN THIRTY EIGHT AND THIRTY NINE MILES OF BREST LITOVSK AND BIALYSTOCK FRONTIERS AT OSEVAYA.

CHICAGO:- HERMAN JONES, VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE PRO ROOSEVELT TEXAS DELEGATION SAID MONDAY THAT IF TEXAS DEMOCRATIC ELECTORS CARRY OUT A THREAT TO VOTE AGAINST THE PARTY NOMINEE THEY WILL "DESTROY PARTY GOVERNMENT AND MOST OF ALL IMPERIL THE INTERNAL PEACE OF THIS NATION". AT A NEWS CONFERENCE JONES CRITICIZED LEADERS OF THE REGULAR STATE CONVENTION SLATE OF UNINSTRUCTED DELEGATES FROM THE LONE STAR STATE FOR "TRYING THE TEXAS CASE IN THE NEWSPAPERS". HE REFERKRED TO DAN MOODY FORMER GOVERNOR AND GEORGE BUTLER, CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE UNINSTRUCTED GROUP ASSERTING "IN TRUTH WE ARE CONTESTING THE SAME BUNCH OF REPUBLICANS AND DEMOCRATS WHO SUPPORTED THE REPUBLICAN NOMINEE IN TEXAS FOUR YEARS AGO AND THE VOTE WAS 3 1/2 AGAINST THEM IN THE ELECTION."

SUPREME HQS ALLIED EXP FORCE:- PRESSURE BY THE ALLIED FORCES HAD LED TO MINOR PENETRATIONS IN NORMANDY NEAR LESSAY, PERIERS, AND ST LO COMMUNIQUE NUMBER EIGHTY FOUR REPORTED MONDAY NIGHT.

BRETTON WOODS, NH:- UNITED NATIONS MONETARY CONFERENCE MONDAY WAS EXTENDED THREE DAYS BEYOND ITS ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED CLOSING DATE TO PERMIT THE VAST AMOUNT OF TECHNICAL WORK TO BE COMPLETED WITHOUT PRESSURE. AS A RESULT OF THE DECISION THE WASHINGTON HOTEL DISPATCHED TELEGRAMS TO SEVERAL HUNDRED PROSPECTIVE GUESTS DELAYING OR CANCELING THEIR RESERVATIONS. THE SESSIONS HERE ALREADY HAVE BROUGHT AGREEMENT ON PLANS FOR AN EIGHT BILLION DOLLAR POST WAR PROSPERITY FUND.
